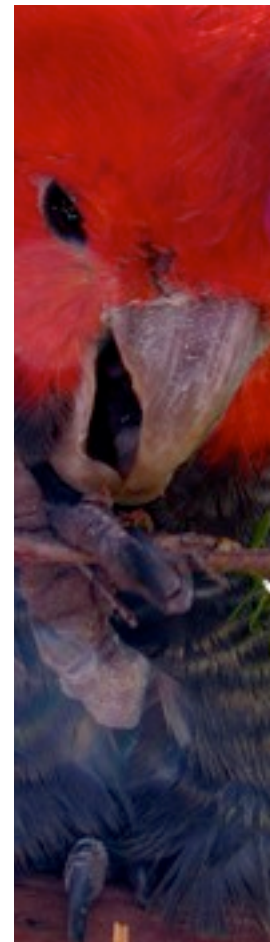
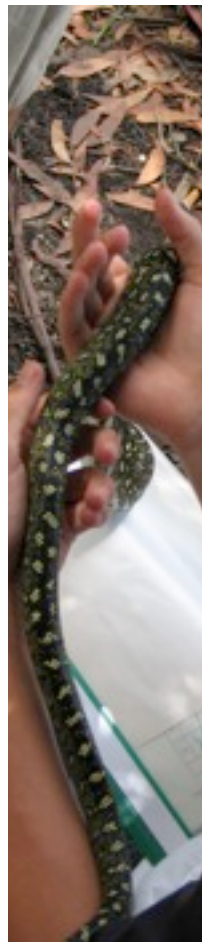
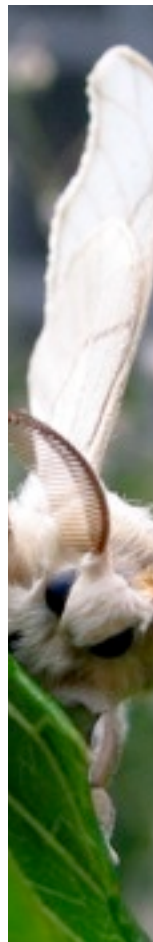




# mars alive
